The Detachment Convention is well behind us, and what a Convention it was! It was very productive and well attended from all Squadrons around the Detachment. We had attendance at the meetings of over 350 delegates. This speaks very well for the organization and for you the members of this GREAT DETACHMENT! The Convention concluded with the election of Thomas Klinger of Squadron 7 Clearwater as your Detachment Commander for 2018-2019. A complete list of the new Detachment Officers is in this issue of The Source.

We continue to be very successful in our programs. It was very evident in Membership with another All Time High of 19,000+ members. We had 121 year-end reports submitted. In addition, we had 117 National CSR forms submitted. The Detachment Year End reports submitted should have matched what was submitted for National. I hope that we can regain the number of reports next year. I personally wish to THANK everyone that submitted the reports. From the reports submitted, a total of \$1,367,304 was donated to various programs and over 465,476 man-hours were recorded. A hearty JOB WELL DONE to all of you everything you all did this year.

The Detachment Roster is in the works. Several Squadrons still have not submitted their Squadron Officer Report forms. The District and Area Commanders will be getting a list of these Squadrons very soon and will begin to follow up with those Squadrons to get the information. We have set a deadline of August 22, 2017 for this

information to be submitted. After this date, we will be going to print with the Detachment Roster. Without this information on file at Department Headquarters, your Squadron will not receive any information from the Detachment. If you have any questions or wish to check and see if a Squadron has submitted one since Convention, please contact me.

By now, all Squadrons should have received their membership cards for 2019. The cards were delivered at Convention. Department Headquarters should have mailed out any cards not picked up at the Convention. If you still have not yet received them, please contact Membership Director Irene Graham at Department Headquarters.

In closing, I wish to thank Detachment Commander Klinger and the Detachment Executive Committee for reappointing me to serve as your Detachment Adjutant for this my 3rd year. We continue to look for new and inventive ideas to make the Detachment better. If anyone has any ideas or suggestions to help improve the Detachment, please let me know and we will look into them.
