Greetings Membership Team,

Now that the Holiday Season is here, and Thanksgiving is over, Martha and I want to wish you and your families a very Merry Christmas and a safe and Happy New Year.

Now on to membership. This time of year, normally very slow as we have the transition of our out of state members return for the summer. We all need to continue to watch our membership and make sure that the transmittals continue, and our targets are met. We met every target last year and we are off to a great start reaching our first three (3) targets this year. Our next target of 45% is December 6th, 2018.

As of our November 11th report the Detachment was at 39.21% with a renewal rate of 29.43%. We had three (3) Districts at or over the 45% target with no areas at target as of that report. We only transmitted 304 cards for that report. The transmittals were a little low and we need to make sure your Squadrons are up on the target dates and transmitting their cards, even if it is only one (1) card. Do not hold cards. As you can see, we have work to do during our Holiday Season to stay on track with reaching our targets.

We still have several (0) zero Squadrons and I know you are working on them. I am working with and have been working with Squadron 296 in Destin for several weeks to get them back to charter strength. They are very excited and have lots of plans for future growth on Squadron 296. I also worked with Squadron 166 Homosassa in getting some issues at Headquarters on their membership count. With all this said, I really wish that all the District Commanders and their staff make contact and keep contact with there Squadrons. We do not need this to kind of issues to be out there involving our Squadrons. You are the eyes and ears of the Detachment.

Lets all continue to push membership and let's keep our string together for reaching our targets. I know you will continue your hard work and I know that we will again have a very successful year with your hard work and dedication.
