Please understand that the National Helpdesk will only work with the Squadron Adjutant that is on file with them and Department via the submitted officers report.

Greeting Membership Team,

With Fall Conference completed our year is well underway; we now have our task assignments from Commander Klinger. Our November 23rd, 2019 membership report had the Detachment at 45.21% with our 45% target December 11th, 2019. Our renewal rate for the Detachment is 32.92%. We still have 22 ZERO Squadrons that need the attention of the District Officers and membership teams. Other issues that I am going to watch closely are Squadrons that reach 100% and have no other reported membership for the balance of the year. We must recruit new members into ALL Squadrons if we are to grow and you guys are the best at recruiting. I know everyone is working hard on membership and Commander Klinger and I do thank you for that.

Our last report really did not look good as far as numbers, but after some investigating found the problem to be at Headquarters with the membership transmittal changing to the SAL portal. I do know that all Posts and Squadrons can now transmit membership via the SAL portal. Talk to your Post Commander or Adjutant to get on board with the new process. It does help with the report and will in time make it much easier to get your membership done.

The Detachment target numbers shown on this page. You can see that the next three targets are close together and we will have a membership increase of 25% in those three target dates (November, December, & January). During this time, we also have our Holiday season. What I am getting to, is we need to be really staying on top of membership as this time will fly by.

Working membership this year has been very interesting with the passing of the Legion Act and some changes that are being done at the National level. You will hear more about this at Convention or other means of communication when we know of all the changes that are to take place.

All Squadrons need to get signed up and approved for MySAL and start using it. It is going to become a very valuable tool for your Squadron membership.

Fall Conference is now behind us and the 2019-2020 year is officially underway. We had a very well attended Conference with lots of great work completed along with lots of information to be past along to our members.

We once again had discussions about our members not knowing who to contact for questions and concerns. We have got to get this right. Our web site has all the Commission/Committee chairman and all the officers that would need to be contacted. Texting, Facebook, messenger, Face Time are not the way to contact and communicate with one another. We need to be making a phone call or sending an email to the person you are taking to. This way, if others are needed in the conversation they can be included, and you will get the information you were looking for. Let's all tighten up on our communication skills.

With the passing of the "LEGION ACT" there have been lots of verbiage changes within The American Legion. With these change The Sons of The American Legion will also have lots of changes to be made to our manuals, membership applications, membership eligibility requirements, requirements of Detachment Officers, Committee/Commission members just to name a few. Lots of stuff has been discussed without the correct information to pass on to our membership. This has got to stop! Most all the changes may require a resolution to make the changes, these resolutions must be brought to the floor of the Fall Conference or our annual Convention. None of the things the Legion has passed influences us until "WE" vote on and adopt a resolution for each particular change. Some of the changes may require a resolution, some may be an administration changes. Everyone will be informed when the time comes, and we have gotten our information from National. Until that time comes, it is business as usual without the unnecessary conversations and statements.

As we mentioned during the Fall Conference, we are now able to process membership through the MySAL Web Portal. Instructions on how to process membership using the portal have been distributed and needs to reach all Squadrons. Please review the information and understand how this is to work. If your Squadron is not using MySAL, you need to request access. National needs to verify the information you provide so, ensure that your Squadron has submitted an officer's report form prior to requesting access. The Squadron Adjutant is the only one that will be granted access provided information is on file. The Member Training & Development Committee needs your help: WE NEED INSTRUCTORS. Please provide me a resume of your instruction capabilities. We must get this done and it needs to happen now. We only have 3-4 instructors and we need your help. If you have the background or think you are interested, please get your resume to me and I will pass the information on to Chairman Roberts.

Please use this page to submit your District Constitutional Conferences. This will allow your Area Commanders and others to see when your DCC is being held and attend. The only DCCs listed currently are **Districts 5,8,13 & 15**. Again, District Commanders, please submit your DCC schedule as soon as possible.

All of the above listed pages can be found on the main menu under the "MEETINGS" tab.

Lastly, I would like to thank those who are submitting your events through the website. The use of the event submission form is continuing to grow, which is fantastic! Remember it doesn't just have to be a Sons event that you are submitting – it can be anything from a Post Family event to an Area Event. A new tool that has just been launched for our Detachment is the ability to process membership online through MySAL.org. This feature utilizes electronic payment methods via MySAL.org, and eliminates the need for Squadron Officers to send the National and Detachment portion of the (3-part) membership cards and paper-checks to the Department/Detachment Headquarters office.

If your Post is already using MyLegion.org to process membership, they can walk you through the process. To access this feature, log in to MySAL.org and select the "Process Membership" option in the left menu. I have posted the instructions in our District 13 Google Group.

If you are NOT a MySAL.org user, go to www.MySAL.org and sign-up by completing the "Squadron Authorization Form"

Endorsements for Office



It is the policy of the Detachment of Florida that no endorsement be posted prior to the Annual Fall Conference. The Detachment of Florida provides this information for the benefit of our membership. The addition of endorsement information does not indicate support for an individual candidate by the Detachment of Florida.

In order for an endorsement to be posted to the Detachment Newsletter "The Source" or the Detachment Website, an endorsement letter must meet the following requirements.

1. Each endorsement letter must come from a Florida Squadron or Post and must be signed by the Squadron Commander and Squadron Adjutant, or the Post Commander and Post Adjutant or any combination of these.
 - a. The letter must be on Squadron or Post letterhead and include the date that the Squadron or Post made the endorsement and that the membership approved said endorsement.
 - b. This letter should contain information explaining why the individual should be considered for the office he is seeking and a narrative of positions held to show his leadership potential.
2. Endorsements will only be accepted for the elected Detachment Officers, District Commanders as follows:
 - a. Detachment Commander, Detachment Vice Commanders, National Executive Committeeman, National Executive Committeeman Alternate, Detachment Historian, Detachment Chaplain, Detachment Sergeant-At-Arms and the District Commanders

Endorsement letters must be submitted, in writing, to the Detachment Adjutant as follows with the required signatures (in the format listed above).

1. Endorsement letters can be sent via the US Postal Service to the Detachment Adjutant Jim Roberts – 2691 Mount Pleasant Rd, Quincy, FL 32352.
2. Endorsement letters can be scanned and sent by e-mail to the Detachment at floridasons@legionmail.org. Scanned documents are required to be in an Adobe Portable Document Format (.pdf) and must have all of the original signatures as required and be of good quality.



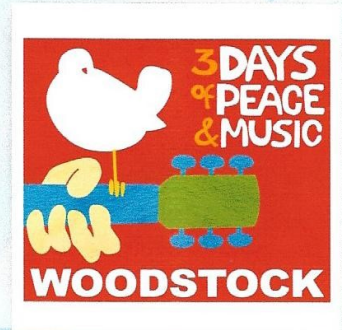
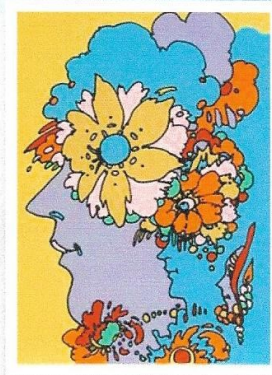
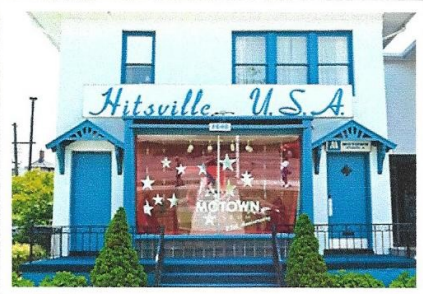
