As our membership year moves along, I will continue to ask the Area, District, and Vice Commanders to look over their membership reports. We have a lot of ZERO's that need to be addressed. As of our November 12th, 2020 report we have 30 ZERO Squadrons. We must make improvements in this area. Get on the phone, send those emails, attend meetings, and have those conversations about what the issues are and let them know we are here to help. We must communicate with these Squadrons. These issues will not just go away by themselves. I would also ask each of you to work with the Squadrons that make their 100% early. These Squadrons have historically not submitted any more membership once they hit that goal. WHY? For the Detachment to continue to grow we must ALWAYS be recruiting NEW members while retaining our current members. Let's watch this during this membership year.

MySAL is a wonderful tool for all Squadrons to use. Once it is set up you can submit your membership, complete address changes along with other functions. It is an extremely easy process. Go to the Detachment website www.floridasons.org and find the MySAL icon. Click on the icon, print the instructions and application, fill out the application and follow the instructions. Only the Squadron Adjutant will be given the access by National. Therefore, the Squadron must have submitted a Squadron Officer Report form, or they will have to submit one before access will be granted. It is an easy process if we have done our jobs. As of our November 12th, 2020 membership report we have 62 Squadrons that have been reported to me using MySAL. As great as that is that is only 32.62% of our Squadrons. This number must increase as the National organization will sometime soon be going completely electronic. We need to be ready for that transition. Get with your Post Officers and get the guidance on getting signed up. We will get this done.

Your Squadron administration manuals should have arrived; if not you can download a copy of the Administration manual online at www.floridasons.org under the administration tab. Look at the target dates and get them in the hands of our Squadrons. They need to know what is expected and understand that is especially important that we reach these targets. Membership is our life-line.

We need to have better contact information for all members. Correct records including Phone numbers, email addresses, and up to date mailing addresses are vital and COVID-19 showed us why that is important. Let's be proactive and put a plan in place and execute it so that we will have many more better-informed members.

 - Ensure that postal mailing addresses are correct
 - Ensure that phone numbers for members are correct

It should be very clear that MySAL is an important and vital tool for all Squadrons.

The Source is the official Detachment of Florida Newsletter, published each month of each service year—this is a wholly underutilized tool that every Squadron should be leveraging to their benefit. It is NOT just a place for Detachment Officers, Chairs of Committees and Commissions and District Officers. PREAMBLE TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION

ASSOCIATE OURSELVES TOGETHER AS "SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION" FOR THE FOL-LOWING PURPOSES:

- To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America;
- to maintain law and order; to foster and perpetuate a true spirit of Americanism;
- to preserve the memories of our former members and the associations of our members and our forefathers in All Wars;
- to inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state and nation;
- to combat the autocracy of both the classes and masses;
- to make right the master of might;
- to promote peace and good will on earth;
- to safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of justice, freedom and democracy;
- to consecrate and sanctify our friendship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness;
- to adopt in letter and spirit all of the great principles for which The American Legion stands;
- and to assist in carrying on for God and Country.

As we wind down this crazy year and plan for the New Year, I'd like to remind you of 3 tools you have available at absolutely NO COST to you and you Squadron. These tools will help you communicate better throughout your Districts, Areas and the Detachment. What are these tools? These tools are your Detachment Officers and your Public Relations Committee!

• TOOL #1: The Detachment of Florida Website

We have worked hard over the past year and a half to make our website easier for you to use and provide information on your Events, District Meetings and more. The latest membership reports, editions of "The Source", administrative documents, manuals, Detachment Officer/Committeemen contact information and more are right at your fingertips! Although most of us are able to have events right now, attendance is still down. One way to perhaps boost your attendance is to have the Detachment promote your event and get the word out through all of our various outlets. Please consider submitting your event information, including District Meetings/Training/Post Family Events, through our website. You can use the event submission form at https://floridasons.org/event-submission-form/

TOOL #2: The Detachment Mailing List

While we are still getting new subscribers, we still have a very small portion of our 19,559 members signed up to receive our Detachment communications. In fact, as of this writing we only have 349 members signed up to receive communication that's only 1.78% of our membership! If you've been to a Convention or Conference, you've heard Membership Chairman John Jennings say that it is important that all Squadrons make a move to the digital age, as paper communications are being phased out by the National organization. I would encourage all reading this (that means you're are one of the subscribed members!) to share this with your Squadron's membership and encourage them to sign up to receive Detachment Communications. To join our email group, simply send an email to florida-sons-subscribe@googlegroups.com

TOOL #3: mysal.org

Again, if you've been to a Convention or Conference, you've heard Membership Chairman John Jennings say that it is important that all Squadrons make a move start processing their membership through the mySAL.org portal. Here's a very good possibility that in 2021, this will be your only way to process membership transmittals. It is super easy to use once you have it set up. It takes less than a minute to process a renewal. If you haven't signed up of mySAL.org yet (why wouldn't you??) simply go to www.mysal.org and click on the REGISTER button. You will first have to complete an Authorization Form that Post Leadership will need to assist you with. It's simple, it's easy, and it's FREE

We have more tools available, but these are the most important ones to get familiar with as we go into the New Year.

Finally, I'd like to remind you that as we look into going into the New Year and you are planning to run for a District Commander/District Vice Commander/Area Commander or a Detachment Officer Position – after you have your Squadron's Endorsement, you'll need to submit an endorsement letter with a signature from Post and Squadron Leadership. You can email them through the contact page of our website or directly to Adjutant Sheubrooks at floridasons@legionmail.org.

Endorsements for Office



It is the policy of the Detachment of Florida that no endorsement be posted prior to the Annual Fall Conference. The Detachment of Florida provides this information for the benefit of our membership. The addition of endorsement information does not indicate support for an individual candidate by the Detachment of Florida.

In order for an endorsement to be posted to the Detachment Newsletter "The Source" or the Detachment Website, an endorsement letter must meet the following requirements.

- 1. Each endorsement letter must come from a Florida Squadron or Post and must be signed by the Squadron Commander and Squadron Adjutant, or the Post Commander and Post Adjutant or any combination of these.
 - a. The letter must be on Squadron or Post letterhead and include the date that the Squadron or Post made the endorsement and that the membership approved said endorsement.
 - b. This letter should contain information explaining why the individual should be considered for the office he is seeking and a narrative of positions held to show his leadership potential.
- 2. Endorsements will only be accepted for the elected Detachment Officers, District Commanders as follows:
 - a. Detachment Commander, Detachment Vice Commanders, National Executive Committeeman, National Executive Committeeman Alternate, Detachment Historian, Detachment Chaplain, Detachment Sergeant-At-Arms and the District Commanders

Endorsement letters must be submitted, in writing, to the Detachment Adjutant as follows with the required signatures (in the format listed above).

- 1. Endorsement letters can be sent via the US Postal Service to the Detachment Adjutant Ed Sheubrooks 800 S. Brocksmith Rd., Fort Pierce, FL 34945.
- Endorsement letters can be scanned and sent by e-mail to the Detachment at floridasons@legionmail.org. Scanned documents are required to be in an Adobe Portable Document Format (.pdf) and must have all of the original signatures as required and be of good quality.
