Included in this mailing is information on the National Consolidated Squadron Report (CSR), and a new form National is requiring all Squadrons to complete. It is the Annual Squadron Data Report (SDR). Both of these forms for National can be filled out electronically and submitted to the National Organization. Both of these forms are already posted on our Website as well. All forms must be completed and sent back to the Detachment Adjutant. The Detachment's Year End Reports are used to determine several Detachment Awards. By not completing them, you omit your Squadrons chance of winning the Awards. The CSR is required by National Headquarters. This is the only report form that will be accepted by the National Organization. Again, by not completing the CSR, it eliminates your Squadron from any National Awards. Please remember that even if your Squadron had "NO ACTIVITY" last year you must return the reports with NO ACTIVITY written on them.

Please take a moment to make your reservations for the upcoming Detachment Convention in July if you have not yet done so. All meetings will be at the Marriott World Center in Orlando. Anyone coming in on Thursday will enjoy going to the Concert that evening. It is hosted by the American Legion Family and free food and drinks will be available. Please review the tentative attached Convention Agenda. On Friday, July 2nd, we will have our DEC meeting at 9:30am; the opening session will begin at 1:30 pm. We will be trying to fit all of what is needed into a short period of time. The Committees and Commissions meeting will be held immediately following the DEC meeting. With having the opening session on Friday, this will let us have all of our members attend the Committee meetings. We look forward to seeing you there!

By now, all District Commanders should have their meeting dates and times scheduled for their District Constitutional Conferences. I have not received any of these dates or meeting times. Please forward them to me as soon as possible and we will get them posted on the Website. All District Commanders MUST hold a meeting and election of new District Officers for the coming year. We want to go into Convention with a full slate of Elected District Commanders. Please remember that you do not have to hold your Conference in conjunction with The American Legion's. Detachment of Florida — Call to Detachment Convention

The 49th Annual Convention of the SAL, Detachment of Florida is hereby called for in compliance with Article V of the Detachment Constitution.

PURPOSE: The convention is called for the electing of Officers, receiving reports and for the transaction of such business which may be properly brought before it.

REPRESENTATION: Representation shall be in compliance with the provisions of Article V, Section 4 of the Detachment Constitution and other sections that may be applicable. A registration fee of \$5.00 will be paid to the Detachment Convention Headquarters for each delegate and alternate registered.

IMPORTANT INFO: Voting strength of Squadrons shall be determined by the membership paid into Department Headquarters by the close of business on June 17, 2021. Forms for the certification of delegates and alternates are in the administrative manual. We will keep in accordance with Article XI, Section 8 of the Department Constitution and By-Laws that reads as follows: "No post or squadron with past due accounts owing the Department of Florida and unsettled before the convening of the Annual Department Convention


Detachment of Florida — Election of Officers

In accordance with the Detachment of Florida Constitution, Article IX District Organization, Section 8 and Article X Squadron Organization, Section 13.

All Squadrons must be elected annually and certified to the Detachment and Department Adjutants not more than 60 days nor less than 10 days prior to the opening of the Annual Detachment Convention. The election of Squadron and District Officers this year must be held between Monday, May 3, 2021 and June 22, 2021.

Detachment of Florida — District Constitutional Conferences

District elections must be held in accordance with Article IX, Section 8 of the Detachment Constitution, which states, "there shall be held in each District a District Constitutional Conference not more than sixty (60) nor less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the Detachment Convention." This means that your elections must be completed between May 3, 2021 and June 22, 2021.





Greeting Membership Team,

CONGRATULATIONS to everyone on reaching our first seven membership goals (10%, 25%, 35%, 45%, 60%, 75%, and our 80%). As of March 18th, 2021, the Detachment is at 90.94% with our 90% goal being April 14th, 2021, you guys have blown that out of the water, again. Congratulations, you guys are the best. Keep up the hard work!! Let us make another "BIG SPLASH" for Commander Klinger and give him another all-time high along with his goal of 20,750+ members. To reach Commander Klingler's goal, we need to reach 20,750 by June 16th, 2021. As of March 18th, 2021, we are short 2,960 to hit that number. We can do this, and we need to make up the lost ground from last year. Let us make this a priority in our membership campaign to give it all we can and hit that goal of 20,750 members.

I am again asking the Area, District, and Vice Commanders to look over their membership report. We have a lot of ZERO's that need to be addressed. As of our March 18th, 2021 report we have 11 ZERO Squadrons. This number is decreasing but we

must make improvements in this area. Get on the phone, send those emails, attend meetings, and have those conversations about what the issues are and let them know we are here to help. We must communicate with these Squadrons as the issues will not just go away. I would also ask each of you to work with the Squadrons that make their 100% early. These Squadrons have historically not submitted any more membership the rest of the year. WHY? For the Detachment to continue to grow we must ALWAYS be recruiting NEW members while retaining our current members. Let us watch this during this membership year.

We need to continue to always stay focused on our membership. We all need to remember the **3 "R's"** (Renew, Reinstate, & Recruit). **"RENEW"** our current members, **"REINSTATE"** our AWOL members, and **"RECRUIT"** new members to continue to grow your Squadron, the Detachment, and our National organization. It is a process, so let us work the process.

The 2021 Recruitment Award application is available and can be accessed by clicking here. When completed and sent, it gives the recipient an opportunity to be properly recognized for their work in helping to grow our organization. The pins are genuinely nice. Just to let you know, we are in the South Region and Jason Roberts is the go-to person and his contact information is on the form.

MySAL is a wonderful tool for all Squadrons to use. Once it is set up you can submit your membership, complete address changes along with other functions. It is an extremely easy process. Go to the Detachment website www.floridasons.org and find the MySAL icon. Click on the icon, print the instructions and application, fill out the application and follow the instructions. The only issue at this time the Squadron Adjutant will be given the access by National. Therefore, the Squadron must have submitted a Squadron Officer Report form, or they will have to submit one before access will be granted. It is an easy process if we have done our jobs. As of our December 17th, 2020 membership report we have 76 Squadrons that have been reported to me using MySAL. As great as that is, this number represents only 37.23% of our Squadrons within the Detachment. This number must increase and once again I am tasking the Area and District Staff to work this issue. The National organization will be going completely electronic in the very near future. We need to be ready for that transition. Get with your Post Officers and get the guidance on getting signed up. We will get this done.

The Squadron Administration Manual is a great resource and all Squadrons should have at least one available. Look at the target dates and get them in the hands of our Squadrons. They need to know what is expected and understand that is especially important that we reach these targets. Membership is our life line.

We need to have better contact information for all members. Phone numbers, email addresses, and up to date mailing addresses. COVID-19 showed us why that is important. So, let us be proactive and put a plan in place and execute it, by doing this we will have much better-informed members.

The convention information is posted on the Department of Florida website and I am sure it will be posted on our website as soon as the information in made available to the webmaster. Keep your eyes on the prize! It will be a wonderful Convention with lots of awards to be given out. Anyone interested in becoming a Detachment officer should get their endorsement letters to the Detachment Adjutant prior to Convention.

Each Squadron at this time should be making plans for the nomination & election of new Officers for the 2021–2022-year, Squadron Officers report form (<u>a requirement</u>) completed and sent in, both Detachment and National consolidated report forms, and any other activity reports that your Squadron has done during the year. An example of the things a Squadron can report on, work hours in the Post, monies donated to the Post, Help with dinners or activities other than the Squadron activities. Squadron activities generally as a fundraiser for a program and should be in that program report. These are just a few of the examples of what each Squadron should be collecting and reporting on.

District Commanders should be looking at and planning their Constitutional Conferences for the purpose of Officers elections for the 2021-2022 year so that they can be ratified at Convention.

Back onto communications. Does your Squadron have an email account? If not, why? In these times communication is especially important to maintain good communication with our members. Talk with your Post Commander or Adjutant and discuss using their computer if the Squadron does not have one. Perhaps you could have a fundraiser and purchase one for the family.

NOTE: I attended a National Conference call last month and there is an ongoing push towards electronic reporting. Please review Detachment Adjutant Ed Sheubrooks' article and get the forms from our <u>website</u>.

I made this same statement last month. As we continue to grow our needs will be ever changing and we must be prepared for these changes. - Improve Squadron reporting
 - Fillable forms are available at the Detachment Website.
- Improve Communication
 - Gather email addresses for Squadron members
 - Gather email addresses for Squadrons
 - Ensure that postal mailing addresses are correct
 - Ensure that phone numbers for members are correct

As you can see MySAL is an especially important tool for all Squadrons. It is coming and we need to be ready.

IMPORTANT: In order for your Squadron's membership to pay online and for your Squadron to be able to use the myLegion/mySAL system, each Squadron MUST COMPLETE THE ALL NEW ANNUAL SQUAD-RON DATA REPORT (SDR). This needs completed BEFORE MAY 1st! Head over to the Detachment Website NOW and complete the form at https://floridasons.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/02/SDR.pdf

Please start completing and sending in your year-end reports. ALL REPORTS ARE DUE BY JUNE 1st. Endorsements for Office



It is the policy of the Detachment of Florida that no endorsement be posted prior to the Annual Fall Conference. The Detachment of Florida provides this information for the benefit of our membership. The addition of endorsement information does not indicate support for an individual candidate by the Detachment of Florida.

In order for an endorsement to be posted to the Detachment Newsletter "The Source" or the Detachment Website, an endorsement letter must meet the following requirements.

- 1. Each endorsement letter must come from a Florida Squadron or Post and must be signed by the Squadron Commander and Squadron Adjutant, or the Post Commander and Post Adjutant or any combination of these.
 - a. The letter must be on Squadron or Post letterhead and include the date that the Squadron or Post made the endorsement and that the membership approved said endorsement.
 - b. This letter should contain information explaining why the individual should be considered for the office he is seeking and a narrative of positions held to show his leadership potential.
- 2. Endorsements will only be accepted for the elected Detachment Officers, District Commanders as follows:
