

How many of you have had District meetings? What is the turnout like?

Figure out how to get your district to come and participate. Have a game plan and put it in motion. Mentor the next leaders of this Detachment, District, or Squadron. Help them understand the purpose of each office and keep the membership informed.

As of January 1st, MYLegion.org is accepting membership on-line. *Squadrons*: you MUST have your <u>SDR</u> turned in to National before this will benefit you. If this report is not turned in and a member pays their dues on-line your Squadron will not receive any monies. They will charge the member \$11.00, the national and Detachment per capita together and that's it. You will have to run down that member to receive the rest.

Going forward, gentlemen, this is our future and it is here to stay. So you need to get your Squadrons on board now and stop playing catch up. As I have said before if your Squadron does not have a computer ask the Legion or Auxiliary, or even another Squadron if you can use theirs, until such time as you can purchase one. Now let's get out on that field and help Florida Score for Veterans by tackling their needs.

In these first 6 months I have tried to travel where I could as time would allow. Work has changed now and then preventing me from doing more. I hope to get out to more districts soon. Gentlemen,

By now the Holiday's are behind us and I hope that everyone had a Merry Christmas, and a safe Happy New Year. It seems that each year it goes by faster and faster.

With the start of the New Year, it brings us to that time of the year when if you haven't paid your 2022 membership dues yet, you are considered a delinquent member and should not be allowed into the Post home. For many of you that enjoy the Post Canteen this will have an impact on you. Please pay your dues today to your Squadron. It's to your benefit!!!

Speaking of membership, we currently stand at 12,945 members paid into National Headquarters. It's a long way from the 21,000 we are looking for just to reach a little over 100%. We have always been at the TOP of the National records, but this year we are lagging way behind. I know part of this has had to do with the impact of the MyLegion and MySAL. However, we cannot continue to put the blame on this. We have stated that even if you cannot get on-line, send your cards and check the old fashioned way to JoAnn at Department Headquarters and she will process and forward to National for you.

At the time of me writing this article, we still have 18 "ZERO" or GOOSE EGG Squadrons within the Detachment. This is unacceptable considering your Officer's dues should have been paid prior to their installation as a Squadron Officer. If your Squadron is holding membership you are in violation of the Detachment's Constitution and By-Laws. Your Charter can be revoked because of this. All dues must be transmitted within thirty days of payment.

Once the MyLegion site is up and running, your Squadron MUST submit a Squadron Data Report (SDR) to National Headquarters. This can be completed on-line and submitted. Why is this important to your Squadron? Once the MyLegion site is up and running a member will be able to go on-line and pay their dues. If your Squadron has not submitted the proper paperwork, the member will only be billed \$11.00 for the National and Detachment per capita. They will be able to print their card and be able to go to the Post and such. The Squadron must then go after the member for the balance of the dues. So you can see it is your BEST INTEREST to complete this form and submit today. Please send me a copy as well.

Endorsements for Detachment Office are being accepted. They are also being published in *The Source* and are all on the website to read. The Endorsements must be signed by the Post or Squadron Commander and Adjutant and submitted by email, or regular mail to the Detachment Adjutant. I am sending them to our Web Master, Christian Rapp (323 Lehigh Acres) as soon as I receive them.

The 50th Anniversary Convention Committee is working hard to make sure we have a GREAT Convention in June. We are asking anyone interested in submitting a design for a Challenge Coin to submit them to John Jennings and myself. In addition if anyone has any ideas on a 50th Logo submit them as well. We hope to have all submissions by the end of January. There are some good plans in place already! This is your 50th Convention so all ideas and suggestions will be considered.

That wraps it up for this month. Remember, *The Source* is your newsletter and articles are needed to keep it going!

By the time this article is published, we should have received our first reports for National on the new MyLegion.org system by Squadrons. We will have to wait and see, but this is what we are being told by National.

This brings me to the Squadrons Data Report Form (SDR). You will be hearing a lot more about this as this is now NOT AN OPTION. Your Squadron MOST COMPLY! You will be hearing more on this very soon.

Remember the three "R's" when working membership. We must continue to "Reinstate" and "Renew" our current members and "Recruit" new members. Keep up your great work!

Commander Carter and I both want this year (2021-2022) to be another record year. I am asking now that each Area, District, and Squadron get on top of your membership early. Being early just gives you a better seat in the room. So, let's all make the commitment that Zero Squadrons and slow reporting Squadrons will not be and issues this year. You ask how? Communication, Communication, and Communication; then follow up with visitations, visitations, and visitations. We must Communicate and Visit to reach Commander Carter's goal of 21,000+ members.

It is a requirement that each District Commander completes and forwards to our Detachment Adjutant two (2) visitation forms per year for each Squadron within your District. This does not include installations or special events. Again, that is two (2) Squadron visitation forms per Squadron per Year. NOW MANY HAVE YOU COMPLETED?

Below is some great information that needs to be communicated to every Squadron along with this article. If we are asking for them to react, they need to know what to react to. Please pass this along.

Let's make this year even more fun as we will be having our 50th Anniversary Convention when all the great work is disclosed. The Committee has had two (2) conference calls and things are starting to take shape. A separate article will be written when we have information locked in to communicate to our membership.

Endorsements for Office



It is the policy of the Detachment of Florida that no endorsement be posted prior to the Annual Fall Conference. The Detachment of Florida provides this information for the benefit of our membership. The addition of endorsement information does not indicate support for an individual candidate by the Detachment of Florida.

In order for an endorsement to be posted to the Detachment Newsletter "The Source" or the Detachment Website, an endorsement letter must meet the following requirements.

- 1. Each endorsement letter must come from a Florida Squadron or Post and must be signed by the Squadron Commander and Squadron Adjutant, or the Post Commander and Post Adjutant or any combination of these.
 - a. The letter must be on Squadron or Post letterhead and include the date that the Squadron or Post made the endorsement and that the membership approved said endorsement.
 - b. This letter should contain information explaining why the individual should be considered for the office he is seeking and a narrative of positions held to show his leadership potential.
- 2. Endorsements will only be accepted for the elected Detachment Officers, District Commanders as follows:
 - a. Detachment Commander, Detachment Vice Commanders, National Executive Committeeman, National Executive Committeeman Alternate, Detachment Historian, Detachment Chaplain, Detachment Sergeant-At-Arms and the District Commanders

Endorsement letters must be submitted, in writing, to the Detachment Adjutant as follows with the required signatures (in the format listed above).

- 1. Endorsement letters can be sent via the US Postal Service to the Detachment Adjutant Ed Sheubrooks 800 S. Brocksmith Rd., Fort Pierce, FL 34945.
- Endorsement letters can be scanned and sent by e-mail to the Detachment at floridasons@legionmail.org. Scanned documents are required to be in an Adobe Portable Document Format (.pdf) and must have all of the original signatures as required and be of good quality.




