END OF YEAR DOCUMENTS AND REPORTING

By now you all should have received your end of the year reporting packets. Here are some tips for completing your reports properly:

- The hourly rate for volunteering according to the IRS is \$29.95 per hour. Use this amount to calculate your hours to dollars amount. Use this rate per person, per event.
- On all of your Detachment Reports (Americanism, VA&R, C&Y, etc) DO NOT LEAVE ANY LINE BLANK. If you do
 not have data for a line, please indicate N/A or \$0. Reports with blank lines will disqualify your Squadron from winning an award.
- myLegion.org portal. When your Adjutant or Commander logs into the portal and navigates to their group, the Consolidated Reports screen will appear. There will be a button on the screen that says **Submit CPR / CSR Reports**. (see screenshot). Click the button and begin completing your report. You can also get to the reports page by clicking on the **SUBMIT CPR / CSR RE-PORTS** text link in the left sidebar.
 - NOTE: this is the NATIONAL report. You will still have to complete the DETACHMENT report and send them to me

Once your elections are completed, send the form to Bekki Tibbs at Department (address is on the form). **DO NOT SEND THIS WITH YOUR END OF YEAR PAPERWORK**.

BLANK MEMBERSHIP CARDS

I have had several Squadrons contact me in over the last few weeks in need of more blank membership cards. (That's Fantastic!). If you need more blank membership cards, please reach out to JoAnn Collins at Department. You can reach out to her by email at jcollins@floridalegion.org or you can call Department at (407) 295-2631.

Speaking of Membership Cards..... There is a form in your packet labeled "Instructions for Shipping 2023-2024 Membership Cards". Whether you are picking up your new membership cards in person or are having them mailed to your Squadron, you need to fill out this form. Complete the form and send it back to Department HQ ASAP. If we don't receive this form, your membership cards will be available for pickup at Convention. Any sets of unclaimed cards will be mailed to your Squadron after Convention.

SILVER STAR PIN

As was relayed last Convention, this will be the last year for the Silver Star Pin program, due to cost and lack of participation. The Silver Star award is for those that have helped secure members throughout the year. It is a points-based system. A member will need to have at least 10 points to earn the award. Points: 1 for renewal, 2 for a new member and 2 for a reinstated member. Form needs to be completed and sent to Department HQ by **June 1, 2023**.

NOTE: if you are submitting multiple forms, please indicate on the form 1 of 3, 2 of 3, etc.

As both JJ and I have said before, these reports inform National the amount to collect for dues with the online system. If National does not have this information, they will only collect the \$11 per capita. This means your Squadron will have to chase down the difference from your members that pay online. It only takes a few minutes. Complete the form and send it to me today. I will have blank SDR forms available at Convention which you can fill out and hand back to one of the Assistant Adjutants.

I have so much more that I could talk about, but others need to get their articles in. Keep up the great work, we're so close to reaching the Commander's Goal! Hope to see you all soon!

WOW!

As of our March 16th, 2023 membership report we have recruited 3,610 new members and renewed 16,525 members for a total of 20,135 with these numbers the Detachment was standing at 93.57%. You guys blew the socks off the 80% target and have surpassed our 90% goal which is not until April 13th. What a great job by all! The sky is the limit. Let's go big in April 13th, is 100% possible, sure it is with your continued hard work and support. So, let's GO for the 100% by April 13th----CAN WE DO THIS---YES, WE CAN!!!!

We need 2,115 members as of our March 16th report to reach Commanders Sambets goal of 22,250. I know we can get this done and we will.

We need 959 members as of our March 16th report to reach our 28th consecutive all-time high and I am sure we will reach this very soon.

With over 3600 new members we need to take a look at keeping our exiting members. Get them involved, give them something to do, ask them to help. Most will help if ask. We must find a way to keep our members. Look at the above numbers and just think where we could be if we renewed 50% of that 3600 new members and recruited the 3600 new members. That is another big WOW! Just food for thought.

As we continue to work through our membership year let's all remember the three 3 R's of membership.

Reinstate - Renew - Recruit This would be a great Squadron meeting topic to discuss the meaning of each word and the value it brings to the Squadron. Just what do these three simple words mean to you and your Squadron.

WE need to get focused and submit our REQUIRED SDR (Squadron Data Report) form **ANNUALLY**. This is no longer an option to submit and must be submitted to National no later than MAY 1st of EACH YEAR BY EACH SQUAD-RON.

The instructions after the form have been completed. 1st- Save a copy for your Squadrons file. 2nd - email your submission to our Detachment Adjutant Christian Rapp at (adjutant@floridasons.org). Adjutant Rapp will batch submitted to the National IT Department as required keeping record of those submissions which will hold the National IT Department accountable for correct posting or incorrect posting. We will get this resolved with your help and understanding. The form is available on our website.

Another form that is very important to the operation and success of the Detachment is the Squadron Office Report form. It is also available online. If not done, the Detachment has no easy way of contacting you or your Squadron. Please get this completed as it is an important tool for our communication to you the Squadrons and for you to communicate to your membership. Why would you not want to communicate to your membership?

For our membership campaign to be a great success, we must work it each day. Membership is not a part time job – it is a full-time job and it requires WORK. When a Squadron reaches the 100% goal and does not move from that 100%, what does that tell you? I watch this, and I hope all of you will also.

Membership numbers should always be moving in a positive way and never standing still. If a Squadron is to grow it must add new members if they and the Detachment are to grow. We have plenty of resources in Florida and we must reach out to them if the Detachment is to grow.

HOSTING AN EVENT

If you have never hosted or set up an Event, like any project, it takes time, ideas, and a Plan.

Start by deciding what Event you want to do, and WHY. Once you have the What and the Why, you will begin to develop your Plan (How).

I always like to start with a reason. Perhaps, you want Honor a group of some kind. Learn about that group and decide what highlights you wish to include. Find a suitable date, this may necessitate your checking the Post calendar, so you don't run into problems. Ask to hold the date so nobody else starts a project (the When). Are you using the Post facility or a public area, go about finding out how to get the necessary permission. Once the location (Where) is established, you can begin to lay out the steps of your Plan.

Unless it is an unforeseen necessity to do this quickly, allow enough time (at least one month) to pull it together. By the way, it is not unheard of to start a year in advance.

List what has to be done. If there are costs, how will you raise the money? If you need to enlist volunteers, consider your resources. If you need props or adjunct equipment, where can you get it, any cost?

Now you will begin to give shape to the Event. Develop advertising ideas. Local radio shows, newspapers, marquis signs, handouts, etc. I told you this would take time, ideas, and planning.

If there is a script to follow, write it up. You have someone else review it for grammar or spelling, but you need to give the script it's meaning. After all you have the original idea for this.

That original idea is called **Vision**. When you take your Vision and get others involved that is called **Leadership**.

To the beginner, start small, and build from there.

Endorsements for Office



It is the policy of the Detachment of Florida that no endorsement be posted prior to the Annual Fall Conference. The Detachment of Florida provides this information for the benefit of our membership. The addition of endorsement information does not indicate support for an individual candidate by the Detachment of Florida.

In order for an endorsement to be posted to the Detachment Newsletter "The Source" or the Detachment Website, an endorsement letter must meet the following requirements.

- 1. Each endorsement letter must come from a Florida Squadron or Post and must be signed by the Squadron Commander and Squadron Adjutant, or the Post Commander and Post Adjutant or any combination of these.
 - a. The letter must be on Squadron or Post letterhead and include the date that the Squadron or Post made the endorsement and that the membership approved said endorsement.
 - b. This letter should contain information explaining why the individual should be considered for the office he is seeking and a narrative of positions held to show his leadership potential.
- 2. Endorsements will only be accepted for the elected Detachment Officers, District Commanders as follows:
 - a. Detachment Commander, Detachment Vice Commanders, National Executive Committeeman, National Executive Committeeman Alternate, Detachment Historian, Detachment Chaplain, Detachment Sergeant-At-Arms and the District Commanders

Endorsement letters must be submitted, in writing, to the Detachment Adjutant as follows with the required signatures (in the format listed above).

- 1. Endorsement letters can be sent via the US Postal Service to the Detachment Adjutant Christian Rapp 215 Greenwood Ave, Lehigh Acres, FL 33936-1452.
- 2. Endorsement letters can be scanned and sent by e-mail to the Detachment Adjutant at adjutant@floridasons.org. Scanned documents are required to be in an Adobe Portable Document Format (.pdf) and must have all of the original signatures as required and be of good quality.
