SQUADRON OFFICER REPORTS (SORs)

We have not received Squadron Officer Reports from every Squadron in the Detachment. All District Commanders and Area Commanders should be making sure these reports are being turned in. One way to do it would be to take a blank SOR with you to each Installation and have it completed then, even if the squadron says they submitted the report. ANNUAL SQUADRON DATA REPORT (SDRs)

Yes, I'm going to mention this again. I know don't have all of these turned in yet. As we continue to move forward with the myLegion.org system it is imperative that these forms are turned in. This tells the National organization how much to collect for dues when members pay online. More of our members are starting to use the online pay feature. National is also advertising it. Please check to see if your Squadron has done this. I should have a report this week who has/has not sent one out. Look for a group email soon. Awarded by National at National Convention and we have won this award in the past. This is what we must do to qualify.

- 1. Charter 5 New Squadrons
- 2. 105% Membership by National delegate cutoff
- 3. 85% renewal rate by National delegate cutoff

As we continue to work through our membership year let's all remember the three 3 Rs of membership. Reinstate – Renew – Recruit – This would be a great Squadron meeting topic to discuss the meaning of each word and the value it brings to the Squadron. Just what do these three simple words mean to you and your Squadron.

WE need to get focused and submit our REQUIRED SDR (Squadron Data Report) form ANNUALLY. This is no longer an option to submit and must be submitted to National no later than MAY 1st of EACH YEAR BY EACH SQUADRON.

The instructions after the form have been completed. 1st- Save a copy for your Squadrons file. 2nd - email your submission to our Detachment Adjutant Christian Rapp at (adjutant@floridasons.org). Adjutant Rapp will batch submitted to the National IT Department as required keeping record of those submissions which will hold the National IT Department accountable for correct posting or incorrect posting. We will get this resolved with your help and understanding. The form is available on our website. (www.floridasons.org).

For our membership campaign to be a great success, we must work on it each day. Membership is not a part time job – it is a full-time job, and it requires WORK. When a Squadron reaches the 100% goal and does not move from that 100%, what does that tell you? I watch this, and I hope all of you will also.

Membership numbers should always be moving in a positive way and never standing still. If a Squadron is to grow it must add new members if they and the Detachment are to grow. We have plenty of resources in Florida and we must reach out to them if the Detachment is to grow.

Additionally, District Commanders and Vice Commanders, elected at their respective District Constitutional Conferences were notes. All were sworn in on Saturday, June 17th. The installation was conducted by National Commander Chris Carlton and Past National Commander Jim Roberts.

National Executive Committeeman Bill Kelly and Alternate NEC Tom Klinger were elected by the Detachment and will be installed at the Post National Convention National Executive Committee Meeting.

Included in the Detachment of Florida Convention business was a Constitution and By-Laws amendment, changing the NEC and ANEC terms from one year to two years. This mirrors the American Legion Department of Florida Constitution and By-Laws.

A Resolution presented by the Detachment to The Department/Detachment of Florida Executive Committees elevating Ed Sheubrooks, National Assistant Adjutant for 27 years, to PNC status at the time of his retirement from National service was approved.

We introduced from the QR codes for 'Be The One' for veterans suicide prevention, online membership renewal, and Legislative Voter Voice, provided by the National Organization.

We wish our entire Florida American Legion Family another outstanding year in 2023-2024 and we hope to see everyone who attends National Convention in Charlotte.
