A copy of this Notice of Appeal must be delivered to the Commander of the charging entity contemporaneous with the delivery to the Sons of The American Legion, Detachment of Florida.

The entity that brought the charges shall have a right to respond to any allegation or statements in the accused's Notice of Appeal. Said response shall be in writing and filed with the Detachment Adjutant within sixty (60) days from the charging entity's decision.
